### **CSG Committee Information:**

The Cultural Service Grant Committee is comprised of a cross-section of members from Jacksonville’s diverse communities representing racial, gender, geographic and age diversity, who express an interest in the impact of culture in the community and a willingness to participate fully in the grantmaking process.

The CSGP Committee is made up of up to 10 voting members – three from the Cultural Council’s board of directors and seven community representatives. There is also a non-voting committee chair and liaisons from the Mayor’s Office and the City Council.

### **Committee Expectations:**

- Participate in COJ’s Ethics Training as required
- Attend Committee meetings in-person
  - Approximately 6 meetings
- Attend public grant hearings in-person. CSGP Hearing is all day, Capital half a day long.
- Reviewing and scoring applications using the online grants portal
  - Up to 35 CSG applications
  - Up to 20 Capital applications
- Conduct on-site visits of assigned applicants and write an on-site evaluation report for each visit (2-3 visits/committee member, only for the CSGP applications)
- New committee members must reside in Duval County
- Agree to abide by Sunshine, Public Records, and Ethics laws
